- 2. Click on sign in

First in Math (math practice)

- 1. Go to firstinmath.com
- 2. Sign in using student lunch number as the username and birthdate as the password.
- 3. Click GO
- 4. Under play, help your child choose a game that will help him/her become better. Often the kids try games that are too easy to get stickers—but help them realize they get so many MORE stickers when they try harder games. There are games that fit each of our units, so double check Timmy Town Times or timmytowntimes.weebly.com to stay up to date on what we are currently studying.

SOL Teacher (all subjects practice)

- 2. Choose any subject. This site covers all subjects and all third grade SOLs.

Jefferson Lab (for SOL practice on Science and Math skills)

- Go to http://education.jlab.org/solquiz/
- 2. Click on either "Math 3" or "Science 3"
- 3. Click on the number of questions for the quiz.
- 4. Have your child complete the quiz independently to practice reviewing the type of third grade questions he/she will see on this year's SOL.

Raz Kids (reading practice)

- 1. Go to http://www.raz-kids.com/main/Login
- 2. Enter teacher username: ctims25
- 3. Click on student name
- 4. Enter password (student's first name in lowercase letters only)
- 5. Click on "Your Assignment" (This is the level at which your child is reading independently. Once they have completed all books and passed all quizzes, the program will move them to the next reading level.)
- 6. Be sure to check and make sure your child isn't spending TOO much time in the Raz-Rocket room. However, after some hard work at reading the Raz Rocket Room is fun incentives that students can play on as a reward for reading.
